



## **Pz.Kpfw.VI Ausf.B «Королевский Тигр» (позднего производства) с полным интерьером и наборными траками гусениц Германский тяжелый танк II MB**

Самым тяжелым и мощным танком Второй мировой войны был германский Pz.Kpfw.VI Ausf.B. Он был разработан фирмой Хеншель под руководством Э. Адерса.

Серийное производство началось в феврале 1944 г. Танк имел мощное бронирование и длинноствольную 88-мм пушку. Броневой снаряд пушки был способен поразить любой танк союзников на дистанции 2000 м и выше.

В войсках танк получил неофициальные названия «Тигр II» или «Королевский тигр».

С июля 1944 г. на танки устанавливались башни фирмы Хеншель, а с октября 1944 г. – прекратилось нанесение на броню покрытия «циммерит».

Танки Pz.Kpfw.VI Ausf.B до конца войны состояли на вооружении тяжелых танковых батальонов. Всего в 1944-1945 гг. было произведено 479 «Королевских тигров».

### **ВНИМАНИЕ!**

Перед сборкой внимательно прочитать руководство по монтажу. Каждая деталь пронумерована. Соблюдать последовательность монтажа. Необходимые рабочие инструменты: нож и напильник для зачистки деталей; резиновая лента, клейкая лента и зажимы для сушки белья для прижимания склеиваемых деталей. Детали из пластика очистить в растворе мягкого моющего средства и высушить на воздухе для того, чтобы краска и переводные картинки лучше прилипали. Перед приклеиванием проверить, подходят ли детали; клей наносить экономно. Хром и краску удалить с поверхностей склеивания. Небольшие детали покрасить перед тем, как они будут удалены из рамок. Краску необходимо хорошо просушить, только после этого продолжать сборку. Каждую соответствующую переводную картинку отдельно вырезать и примерно на 20 секунд окунуть в теплую воду. На обозначенном месте картинку отделить от бумаги и прижать промокающей бумагой.

## **Pz.Kpfw.VI Ausf.B King Tiger (late production) with full interior and separate track links WWII German Heavy Tank**

The most heavy and powerful tank of WWII was the German Pz.Kpfw.VI Ausf.B. It was designed by Henschel Company under the leadership of E. Aders.

Its serial production was launched in February 1944.

The tank had a heavy armor and long-barreled 8,8 cm cannon. Its armor-piercing projectile was capable of hitting any allied tank at a distance of 2000 m and above. However tank possessed insufficient mobility and reliability of the power plant and the transmission.

The tank received army nicknames Tiger II or Königstiger.

Since July 1944 Henschel turrets were installed, and since October 1944 - applying of the Zimmerit coating was stopped.

Pz.Kpfw.VI Ausf.B tanks until the end of the war served in heavy tank battalions. It were produced 479 Königstigers in 1944-1945.

### **CAUTION!**

Read the instructions thoroughly prior to assembly. Each component is numbered. Adhere to specified sequence of assembly. Tools required: knife and file for removal of components from frame; rubber bond, adhesive tape and clothes pegs for clamping components together after applying adhesive. Clean plastic components in a mild detergent solution and allow to air-dry so that paint and transfers adhere better. Prior to applying adhesive, check to see whether the components fit together; apply adhesive sparingly. Remove chrome and paint from the contact surfaces. Paint small components before removing them from the frame. Allow paint to dry well, and only then continue to assemble. Cut out each transfer individually and immerse in warm water for approx. 20 seconds. Slide transfer off paper and into designated position, then press on with blotting paper.
